

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Clinton County, State of Ohio, through its Board of County Commissioners, will receive bids for CLI-VAR-Guardrail-FY19 as per specifications, until 10:00 a.m., May 9th, 2018 at the office of the Clinton County Commissioners, Court House, 46 S. South Street, Wilmington, Ohio 45177 at which time bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids must be delivered to the Clerk of Clinton County Commissioners prior to the above stated time.

Plans and Specifications for CLI-VAR-Guardrail are on file and may be obtained from the office of Jeffrey B. Linkous, Clinton County Engineer, 1326 Fife Avenue, Wilmington, Ohio 45177. Each bid shall be signed by the full name and business address of each person or company.

Bid or Proposal blanks will also be available with said specifications and must be used in the submission of a bid if said bid is to be considered by the Commissioners.

Each bidder is required to furnish with its proposal, a Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code. Bid security furnished in Bond form, shall be issued by a Surety Company or Corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety.

Each Proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the proposal and all persons interested therein. Each bidder must submit evidence of its experiences on projects of similar size and complexity. The owner intends and requires that this project be completed no later than NOVEMBER 16, 2018.

Prevailing wages rates, as determined by the Federal Dept. of Labor, will apply to this project in accordance with the Davis-Bacon Wage Act.

Only ODOT pre-qualified contractors are eligible to submit bids for this project. Pre-qualification must be in force **at the time of the bid, at the time of the award, and through the life of the construction contract**. Subcontractors are not subject to the re-qualification requirement. The "prime" contractor must perform no less than 30 percent of the total original contract price.

The Board of County Commissioners reserves the right to accept the lowest and best bid, reject any and all bids, and to waive any irregularities in bids.
