Clinton County, State of Ohio, through its Board of County Commissioners, will receive bids for CLI-CR-7-4.33 Farmers Rd. SOUTH Improvements as per specifications, until 10:00 a.m., June 21st, 2017 at the office of the Clinton County Commissioners, Court House, 46 S. South Street, Wilmington, Ohio 45177 at which time bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids must be delivered to the Clerk of Clinton County Commissioners prior to the above stated time.

Plans and Specifications for CLI-CR-7-4.33 Farmers Rd. Improvements are on file and may be obtained from the office of Jeffrey B. Linkous, Clinton County Engineer, 1326 Fife Avenue, Wilmington, Ohio 45177. Each bid shall be signed by the full name and business address of each person or company.

Bid or Proposal blanks will also be available with said specifications and must be used in the submission of a bid if said bid is to be considered by the Commissioners.

Each bidder is required to furnish with its proposal, a Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code. Bid security furnished in Bond form, shall be issued by a Surety Company or Corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety.

Each Proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the proposal and all persons interested therein. Each bidder must submit evidence of its experiences on projects of similar size and complexity. The owner intends and requires that this project be completed no later than JUNE 30, 2018.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable, use Ohio Products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contractor compliance with the equal employment opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, is required.

Bidders must comply with prevailing wages rates on Public Improvements in Clinton County, and Clark Township, Ohio as determined by the Ohio Department of Commerce, Bureau of Wage and Hour Administration, 614.644.2239.
